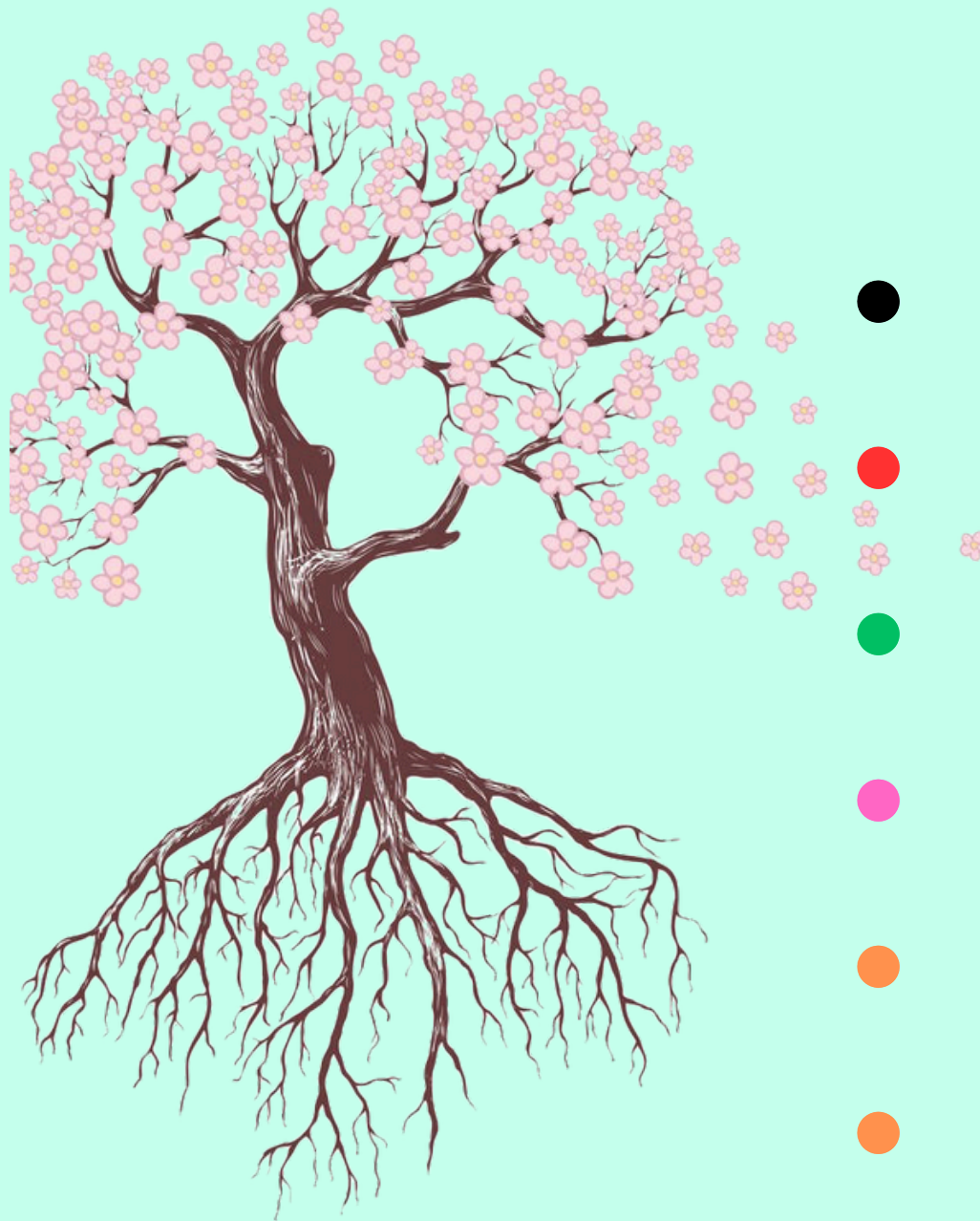

# ROOT

The part of the plant that is under the ground is called **root**.

The plant is attached to the soil with its **root**. It sucks the nutrients it needs - water and mineral salts by its **root**.





# STEM



The **stem** gives support to the plant.  
Along it, water and mineral salts move from the root to the leaves.

# LEAVES



The nutrients needed by the plant are formed in the **leaves**.  
With their help it breathes.



# BLOSSOMS



Fruits are formed  
from the **blossoms**  
of the plant.

# FRUIT

The **fruit** contains seeds or fruit bones from which new plants develop.

This is how plants reproduce.
