<b>First aid</b> is giving immediate assistance to a sick or injured person until professional help arrives (such as the fire brigade).	
<b>Thermometers, bandages and gloves</b> , among other things, should be part of a first aid kit.	
When my skin is <b>burnt</b> , I should use a cool shower gel.	
A <b>fracture</b> is one or more broken bones.	
A <b>sprain</b> is one or more broken bones.	
In a <b>haemorrhage</b> there is blood loss.	
A <b>haematoma</b> is an internal blood loss ("black lump").	
If you are <b>bitten</b> by a domestic animal (such as a dog or cat) it is important to know whether or not it has been vaccinated.	
If you are <b>stung</b> by a bee, it is important to know whether the bee is vaccinated.
